Cast Rehearsals:

This Sunday is our first rehearsal in the Theatre in East Harlsey. Please note the times of the rehearsals and make every effort to **arrive on time for a prompt start at each rehearsal.**

Concentrate and **watch the musical director** so you don't miss the first word of the phrase.

Monday 29th February **18:00 – 21:00** Full Run Through.
Tuesday 1st March **18:00 – 21:00** See Below.
Wednesday 2nd March **18:00 – 21:00** Full Dress Rehearsal.

We hope that you can have quiet night on St David's Day (Tuesday 1st March). We will only have a rehearsal if things don't run smoothly on Monday 29th. The producers will let you know before you leave on Monday 29th whether or not you are needed on the Tuesday evening.

Please **bring a mug** (with your name on it) for drinks in your dressing room.

Costume and Uniform check

During the rehearsal on Sunday 21st in East Harlsey, the wardrobe people will be **checking all clothing to be worn in the show.** Please **wear your full uniform** (for Scouts and Explorers this includes Navy trousers and a Scout Belt) and **bring the other items you have been asked to supply for yourself.** **Please bring ten coat-hangers.**

Stage Crew:

Please attend all the rehearsals at East Harlsey.

The **boards for the back wall** will need collecting from the store on Sunday 21st February and transporting to the Theatre for 12:30. They will need mounting and painting whilst we are there for rehearsals.

We will be **attaching the new legs to the stage extension** (which will also need the new "bottom step") and adding the tapering to the stage.

We will also need to mount and test the projector on Sunday and check how you will attach the pictures to the flats.

Show Days

- Make sure you have a good meal before arriving at the Theatre.
- **Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th March** please be at East Harlsey Village Hall at **18:00**.
- **Saturday 5th** please be at East Harlsey Village Hall at **13:00**.
- You will be ready to leave after the show between 21:30 and 22:00.
- Make sure you **sign out** before you leave.
- On Saturday the whole Gang will have tea together between the shows.
- Please **arrive in your full Uniform, sign in** (with Barry) and **cast go straight to your dressing room**.
- During the show, make sure you keep well hydrated by drinking plenty of water.
- **Keep silent back-stage** – remember the sound carries and the audience only want to hear the people on the stage. Listen for the stage manager's announcements.
- After each show, remove all make-up,
leave your NGS necker in your dressing room and leave in your usual necker.

Getting to East Harlsey Village Hall



From Northallerton:

Take the A684 towards Osmotherly.

Just before you get to Ellerbeck, turn left signposted to East Harlsey.

As you enter East Harlsey, by the "Cat and Bagpipes" pub turn right signposted to Ingleby Arncliffe and the hall will be on your left.

From the Stokesley (A172):

Join the A19 northbound at the Tontine.

From the A19 Southbound:

Leave the A19 at the Tontine, A172 (Stokesley) and join the A19 northbound.

From the Routons:

Follow the signs to East Harlsey.

Once in East Harlsey turn left to the hall on your left.

From the A19 Northbound:

Pass the A172 (Tontine) and then turn left signposted to East Harlsey.

On Entering the village, the hall will be on your right.
